



2018-19 Community Grants Application Guide

Applications are open for the 2018-19 Community Grants, the grants are available to groups or organizations which require funding for a particular project within the Council area that will be of benefit to the local community. The Community Grant applications are assessed using the following criteria to select successful applications;

- 1. Is the project related to a Council activity or Council asset?**
Projects are prioritized which are linked to a Council activity or a Council owned building/area.
- 2. Does the group have its own funds to scope the project?**
Priority will be given to groups which do not have sufficient funds of their own to complete the project.
- 3. Is the project tourism related or of benefit to tourism in the region?**
Projects which are directly going to increase tourism in the area or will benefit tourism will be highly considered, this may include improving the aesthetic of the area.
- 4. Is the project of benefit to the community?**
The Community Grants are aimed at assisting to fund projects run by community members and will benefit the communities within the Council area, projects which can demonstrate benefit to the community as a whole will be prioritized.
- 5. Is the project able to be funded by other sources (including grants)?**
There are many grants available from other organizations and higher levels of government for community groups and sporting bodies to receive funding throughout the year. Fundraising and sponsorship opportunities may also exist for some projects.

Preference will be given to projects which are self-funded (not reliant on other grant moneys) and are ready to be completed by April 30th 2019 to ensure all acquittal documentation is complete and returned by May 31st 2019.
